This memorandum amends our earlier memorandum dated September 12, 2022, the subject of which was *Inter-Tribal Allocation of Settlement Funds*.

Pursuant to requests from several Tribes, this memorandum extends the deadlines set forth in the earlier memorandum by one month. **No further extensions will be granted.** The new deadlines are set forth below. The process and procedures described in the earlier memorandum are otherwise unchanged.

<u>Opening Submissions</u> - Tribes that wish to submit an opening brief on allocation must do so by **November 14, 2022**.

<u>Response Submissions</u> - Tribes that wish to submit a response brief on allocation must do so by **December 5, 2022**.

¹ This memorandum uses the term "Tribes" in the same way as the Janssen Settlement Agreement, to include: (1) a federally-recognized tribe, as provided in the Federally Recognized Tribe List Act of 1994, 25 U.S.C. § 5130; (2) a "tribal organization," as defined in 25 U.S.C. § 5304(I); and an "inter-tribal consortium," as defined in 25 U.S.C. § 5381(a)(5).
